

Your challenges

Manufacturers wishing to export electrical and electronic products to the Member States of the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC), must ensure compliance with the Gulf Technical Regulation for Low Voltage Electrical Equipment and Appliances (BD-142004-01).

What is the Gulf Technical Regulation?

The Gulf Technical Regulation applies to electrical equipment designed for use with a voltage rating of:

- between 50 and 1000V for alternating current
- between 75 and 1500V for direct current

Exceptions are equipment and phenomena listed below:

- Electrical equipment for use in an explosive atmosphere
- Electrical equipment for radiology and medical purposes
- Electrical parts for goods and passenger lifts
- Electricity meters
- Electric fence controllers
- Radio-electrical interference
- Specialised electrical equipment, for use on ships,

aircraft or railways, which complies with the safety provisions drawn up by International Bodies in which the Member States participate.

The Gulf Committee of Conformity Assessment defined two lists of electrical equipment according to the degree of hazard to persons, property or the environment and set the requirements for conformity assessment of the equipment in the lists. List 2 which comprises 13 categories of electrical household appliances requires manufacturers to establish a set of Technical Documentation (including risk analysis, detailed description with conceptual design and manufacturing drawings, etc), have electrical equipment tested by a competent test laboratory and certified by a Notified Body, among others.



Electrical Equipment that complies with the regulation shall bear the "Gulf Conformity Marking" before placing on the market.
